Regular Session Board Meeting Highlights January 7, 2019

The Gates County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, January 7, 2019, at the Board of Education Central Office. Chairman Ray Felton called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. The following board members were present: Mr. Ray Felton, Mrs. Glendale Boone, Mrs. Claire Whitehurst and Mrs. Sallie Ryan. Mr. Byrum was unable to attend due to illness.

Mrs. Glendale Boone made a motion to enter into closed session at 3:00 p.m. and Mrs. Claire Whitehurst seconded the motion to discuss matters that are confidential by law, including confidential student matters, and to approve closed session minutes, pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11(a)(1); to confer with the Board Attorney and preserve the attorney/client privilege as allowed by North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11(a)(3); and to discuss confidential personnel matters as allowed by North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11(a)(6). There was no discussion and the motion carried.

Mr. Felton reconvened open session at 4:00 p.m., with the following board members present: Mr. Ray Felton, Mrs. Glendale Boone, Mrs. Claire Whitehurst and Mrs. Sallie Ryan.

Mrs. Boone made a motion to approve the agenda. Mrs. Whitehurst seconded the motion. There was no discussion, and the motion passed unanimously.

There was a moment of silence, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no Public Comments.

Mrs. Elaine Simpson, representing the Central Middle School Interior Design Committee, reported that the committee had selected an almond color for the gutters and downspouts. They selected blue for the roof. They felt these colors would blend with the existing colors.

During the Superintendent's Report, Dr. Williams presented certificates of achievement to the board members, in honor of January being Board Appreciation Month.

During the Report from the Board, Mr. Felton commented on the lack of progress at Central Middle School. He expressed his frustration with getting the necessary permits needed to begin construction. Other board members commented on the various school events they attended.

Mr. Rube Blanchard, Finance Officer, gave the Financial Report and provided an update on New Beginnings Daycare. He requested that the board approve a mileage rate increase from 53.5 cents per mile to 58 cents per mile (for trips not exceeding 100 miles). Trips that exceed 100 miles will remain at the current reimbursement rate of 33 cents per mile. This is in response to a change in IRS mileage rates, and is effective January 1, 2019, as announced by the Office of the State Budget and Management.

Mrs. Whitehurst made a motion to add the request for mileage rate increase from 53.5 cents per mile to 58 cents per mile (for trips not exceeding 100 miles) as item number twenty-six on the

Consent Agenda. Mrs. Boone seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the motion passed unanimously.
