5. EOG testing will begin on Wednesday, May 30th. It is important to make sure your child gets plenty of rest, be on time, and eat a good breakfast. Below is the testing schedule:

- May 30th - Math for Grades 3-5
- May 31st - ELA for Grades 3-5
- June 1st - Science for Grade 5
- June 5th - Read to Achieve Test for Grade 3
